Any parishioner who is unable to attend Mass is asked to contact the Parish Office for the Sacrament of the Eucharist and the Anointing of the Sick.


SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM




There will not be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on April 24th during CCD. The Second Grade class will be practicing for First Communion in church at that time.




