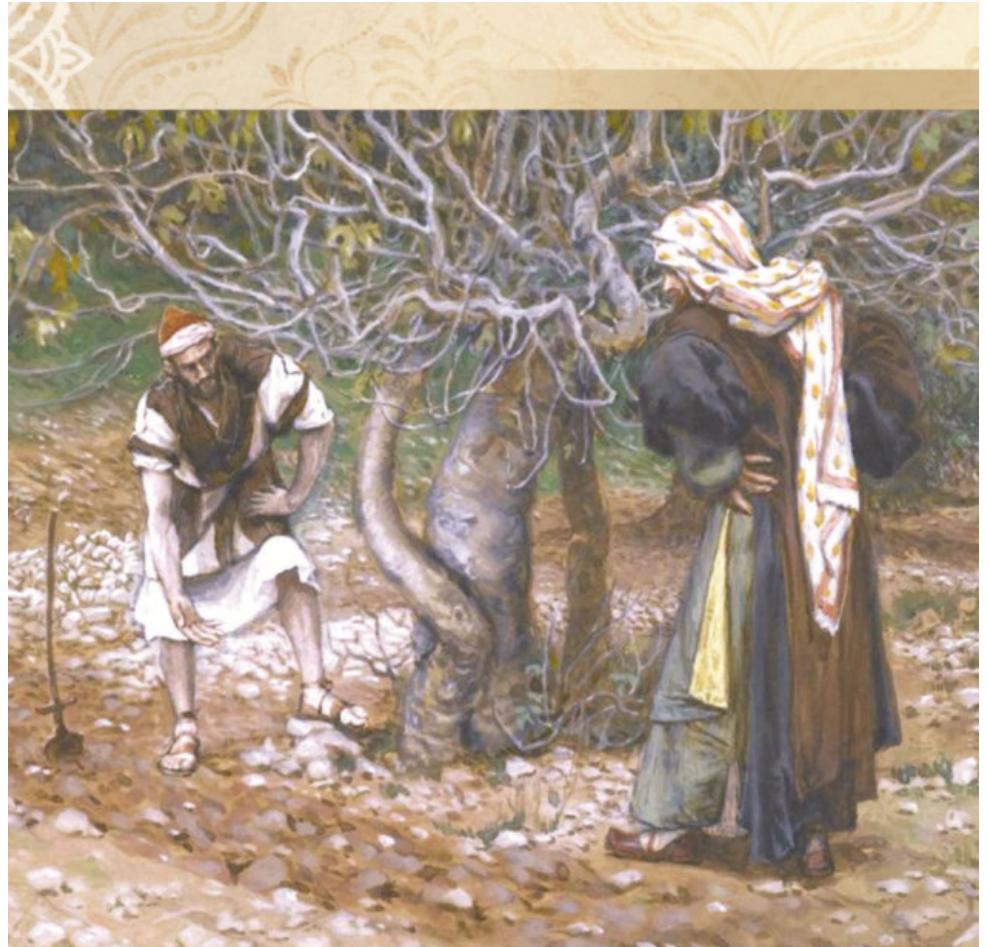
SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

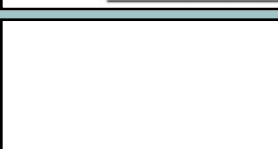
