
SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

The weekend of May 24-25, we will welcome Fr. Rodrigo Ulloa, M.M. for the annual missionary cooperative appeal and collection for the Maryknoll Fathers and Brothers.

Fr. Rodrigo will speak at all the Masses. He is an AF Veteran whose vocation began upon meeting a U.S. Airforce chaplain who became his role model.
