Any parishioner who is unable to attend Mass is asked to contact the Parish Office for the Sacrament of the Eucharist and the Anointing of the Sick.


SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS God's Game of Telephone

You've probably played the game of "pass it on" before, maybe years ago on the playground. It's a simple concept: one person whispers something in another person's ear, and it gets repeated person by person throughout the group, until finally the last one to hear the message has to say it out loud. Whatever ends up being said at the end of the game is usually a far cry from the original statement, and everyone has a good laugh.

As individuals, we don't receive news in the same way. Our personalities, our histories, our weaknesses, and our strengths determine how we interact with information we encounter in the world, both good and bad. One person will interpret a compliment positively; someone else will take offense. One person reacts to news of a job promotion with joy, another is disappointed that now they will have less time with their family. The same news can mean completely different things to different people.

But what God gives us is the truth in love, and the truth in love is the same in every place and in every time, for every person of every race. When Christ prayed to the Father that "the love with which you loved me may be in them," he was asking that the magnificent gift that had been imparted to him would also be imparted to us.

Our job is to play a game of pass it on with this gift of love. How do we keep it from becoming warped? Through remaining committed to the word of God, to the sacraments, and to one another. In this game, we don't change the message. The message changes us. And we have to give it away to keep it.



EDUCATION OF FUTURE PRIESTS SECOND COLLECTION

On June 7, three men will be ordained to the priesthood for service in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis: Deacon, Thomas Day, Deacon Liam Hosty, and Deacon Isaac Siefker. We anticipate ordaining five seminarians to the transitional diaconate. Our Archdiocese has been blessed with a healthy number of seminarians and ordinations in recent years, for which we give thanks to God.

The weekend of June 7-8, we will hold our annual collection for the Education of Future Archdiocesan Priests. This collection supports our seminarians currently studying for future priestly ministry. Your contributions help cover the expenses involved in the education and formation of these future priests. We anticipate having about 28 seminarians this coming fall, including 8 new men who will be entering formation. The average cost per seminarian for educational expenses is about \$55,000 per year. Funds from the United Catholic Appeal and designated endowments support their formation, but those sources do not fulfill the entire need. All donations to this special annual collection will go directly toward the payment of these expenses. Please be generous in supporting this collection and most importantly pray for our priests and seminarians and for an increase in vocations to priesthood.
